STEYN CITY - BLASTING NOTICE

Please take note that Eire Blasting Contractors will conduct a blast at Steyn City Centre One (Shopping Centre Platform) on the 18 July 2012 between 16H30 and 17H00. The blast will be set off at 16H45 but in case of a cut off that reconnection will be done and blast set off again. Please take note that this will also be a substantial blast of a similar magnitude to the previous blast.

CITY OF JOHANNESBURG

While the process of replacing electricity meters that are not working is in progress we are facing new challenges from the City of Johannesburg.

As to the replacement of meters:

The contractor mandated to replace the meters have requested a number of meters to be released from the City Power store room, and the meters will be installed soon after release.

As to City of Johannesburg accounts:

- 1. Information relating to actual installed meters are being lodged with the City of Johannesburg, where billing employees are capturing the data. Unfortunately this process is not error free, and has resulted in several residents reporting questionable monthly statements. Please peruse your monthly statement to ensure that it is reasonable.
- 2. A debt collecting company, working on behalf of City of Johannesburg, got it wrong last week and had Final Demand notices hand delivered to a number of properties based on erroneous information. We received reports of Final Demands being hand delivered addressed to the previous owners of properties for which transfer had taken place more than a year ago, relating to the old account that was / should have been closed two years ago. Enquiries as to the demands resulted in the company in question advising that the demands were sent out in error, and can safely be ignored. Our advice is to therefore carefully check to who any Final Demands are addressed, as well as the account number as noted on the documents. Also, please do not ignore such Demand, as it is indicative of an error at either the company delivering the demand, or at the City of Johannesburg where a closed account was somehow reactivated. This letter of demand should be addressed with both the company who issued the demand as well as with the City of Johannesburg who they represent as failure to do so may result in a contractor being instructed to disconnect services to the property in question notwithstanding the fact that the documentation is addressed to the previous owner!
- 3. The process to address problems on resident City of Johannesburg accounts is ongoing, and a number of residents' accounts are being addressed through various channels.

Meter reading Test project:

A beta project is currently being investigated that may in time give Dainfern residents online access to the meter readings relating to the electricity meters installed at their properties. This may be of interest especially to property owners who rent out their properties.

Pre-Paid meters:

The schedule of residents who indicated interest in installing prepaid meters is nearing finalisation, and this is a final request for residents and property owners who are interested to let us know.
