The Vodacom mast was extensively debated. As a result of the debate it was resolved that a Committee comprising representatives from DHA Management, concerned and

interested residents as well as the Estate Legal Advisor engage with Vodacom with a view to negotiating the removal of the mast from Dainfern and seek an alternative other than a mast, to address signal and capacity on the Dainfern Estate. We shall keep residents informed of the results of these negotiations.
