






Dear Friends A favourite platter.

Why?

Well look at what is written on the back!



Many, many years ago we were lucky enough to visit the 'Eden Project' in 2001 shortly after it opened and 'The Lost Gardens of Heligan' at the same time. When we returned we were asked to give a talk at a Dainfern Garden Club meeting and were presented with the platter as a 'thank you'. We still use it with great joy!



Parthenon, Acropolis, Athens

Sitting on the Stoep

To look straight you have got to build on the skew!

I don't know if you know that but two Greek architects who designed the Parthenon some 2½ thousand years ago did! The Parthenon, built BC 447-438, still dominates the Athens skyline today.

They did two things:

- 1. They humped the floor slightly in the middle - so lower on each side.
- 2. They made the columns very slightly pudgy and leaned them in slightly.

This had the effect of making the floor and the columns look straight.

These two architects built perhaps the most famous and most visible structure in the world that still dominates the ancient city of Athens and they built it skew! They built it with a floor that was not level surrounded by columns that are a little fatter near their middle and which were leaning slightly inwards. But everybody that visits sees a building with a level floor and straight columns – it is eye perfect!

Was it the world's greatest con?

Clever men these ancient Greeks!

How did they know how to get it wrong to get it right?

'Cos get it right, they did!

Of course, somewhere along the way they had that guy called Pythagoras with his 3 4 5 triangle (I used that system to set out our first house in 1966) but that only gives you a right angle so how do you work out the lean on a forty-foot column to make it look straight, when lined up with sixteen others?

Pythagoras lived in the 5th century BC so before the 4th century design and building of the Parthenon, so they had the benefit of his thoughts in the world of numbers and mathematics.

The interesting thing for us is that when we visited the Parthenon with the Classics continue on page 8

Department of Rhodes (how on earth did an engineer qualify for a Classics tour? Only because we knew the twin of the lecturer leading the group) we were made aware of these special features. So, I had the opportunity to line up the floors and columns. My viewing of the floor line at eye level more-orless showed the very slight differences (because I knew it was there) although walking around on the Acropolis everything looked straight.

How did those architects know – amazing.

As an engineer years before our visit to the Acropolis I designed and built a long reinforced concrete bridge across the Macheke River in Zimbabwe. It had fourteen spans and I remember being told that a bridge must always be higher in the middle otherwise it would always seem to sag. But how much? So I made each column half an inch higher to the middle point then down again and it seemed to work very well. When cast and tarred it looked nice and flat despite the fact that it wasn't!

Years later I was ready and waiting when the lecturer described that skewness of the Parthenon, constructed that way to make it look straight. Have any of you noticed the skew?

Birds and Beasties

Rats:

Once again rats are making a nuisance of themselves. Please be very careful of what products are used to avoid secondary poisoning to our wildlife. Live catching is an alternative method, use a reputable eco-friendly company who can do this for you and make recommendations as opposed to you buying products off the shelf which are extremely poisonous to wildlife.

"There was a crooked man, and he walked a crooked mile,



Are You Getting Married?

There are various options available when getting married. Herewith a brief discussion regarding your marital regime options.

1. In community of property:

When entering into a marriage in community of property, the parties each have their own assets and / or own estate. After the date of the marriage the two estates join and become a joint estate (provided no antenuptial contract is concluded). This means that in the event of either of the spouses being declared insolvent, both of the parties will be insolvent.

Should the parties get divorced each party is automatically entitled to half of the estate. Should one of the parties pass away, the surviving spouse will be entitled to half the estate by virtue of the marriage in community of property and the other half by virtue of the will (provided the deceased bequeathed their half share to their surviving spouse in their will).

2. Antenuptial contract without the application of the accrual system:

When entering into a marriage with an Antenuptial contract without accrual, things are a lot simpler for the parties involved. Each parties' respective assets remain as such and upon death, the spouse may bequeath their estate to whomever they wish. Upon divorce the parties will not have an automatic claim to each other's estates and will therefore have

to enter into a settlement agreement. Normally when there are children involved, maintenance claims will take their course.

3. Antenuptial contract with the application of the accrual system:

When entering a marriage with an Antenuptial contract with accrual, before the marriage each spouse owns their own assets and / or estate. Should the parties entering into the marriage not have a net asset value at the start, each party will enter the marriage with a NIL balance and there may be no exclusions from the marriage. Should the parties have an asset portfolio before marriage, they can choose to exclude these assets from the marriage as well as the future growth in these assets.

When entering into an antenuptial contract, the validity of the contract is essential to determine whether you are in fact married with or without a valid antenuptial contract. In order for same to be valid, the antenuptial contract must be concluded/executed prior to the date of marriage before a notary public. The antenuptial contract must then be registered in the deeds office within 3 months from date of execution (in the Republic of South Africa) and within 6 months (outside the Republic of South Africa).



DNA Estate Maintenance **Update**

The Nature Association are continuing to maintain areas on the estate. This year is dedicated solely for maintenance, clean up, education is still a focus, as well as bird walks and talks.

Weeding

Olivia our landscaper is pleased to report that after the weed blitz, which was carried out in May in 15 areas of the Estate, are looking so much better.

The team had to move guite fast to be able to get through the heavy schedule, with absentees and some of the workers taking leave, however the new helpers who were brought in, worked amazingly well, and were a pleasure to work with.

We also gave a helping hand and took the liberty to clean up other areas, normally carried out by golf.

Maintenance & Planting

After the weeding we brush cut some grasslands to just above the rhizomes to allow for the sunlight to get in.

New plantings of love grass have been planted around recent upgrades.

The shade seed grass seeds which were planted just before winter in the corner of the bench at the last dam. is shooting nicely. It will be interesting to see how this grass takes as Olivia is doing a little experiment there with shade grass.

The areas that were all washed away have been fixed and grass planted out along the last stream. The trees in the different areas in Saw Grass have also been lifted. trimmed and the thick tree areas have been cleaned out and new weeds removed.

There are still, lots of Cestrum in the Saw grass areas behind the 4th tee box, which we are going to cut and spray with a systemic spray.

We also removed the sludge at the 4th Dam, and will be removing the Kikuyu growing in the love grass on the bank at the 4th, and then Love grass will be planted when the rains start.

Sludge is also removed off the dams on an ongoing basis.

Clean up

Some of the team will head to the first top dam in Saw Grass at the entry point, as reeds need to be thinned out, and we want to dig and open up some of the silting areas also at the entry point as this is overdue.

Whilst the water level has dropped substantially, this will be a good time to do a clean-up of that area. We have also checked with André Marx and from a birding perspective we have had the go ahead, we will leave pockets of reeds, where necessary and will be once again sensitive to the birds in that area, as we do watch them very carefully when we are working in the dams.


This clean up should take quite a bit of time as the conditions are difficult and muddy.

The other dams are looking OK, not as clear as we would like them, there was one sewerage leak into 3rd Dam, so this was flushed out and 2 more Bio Block tablets have been placed by the weirs to date. Ultimately when funds are available, the dredging machine will still be on the list, and the pump upgrade solution to create more circulation. It is a difficult situation, as the amount of water that comes through saw grass and into Poplar is an unknown quantity, and starts right from the Fourways areas upstream, and as the years have gone by the quantity of water coming down and through those areas have increased tremendously and is a worry.

Aloes

A blitz has been done on Aloes that have been identified with Aphids.

The Aloes and succulents are looking amazing (and if you take the time to watch, the sunbirds are happily flying around too...) the upgrades around the different areas, are quite beautiful at this time of the year.

Perfect Garden this July

July is the time to Prune.

Aim to get your pruning done between the last two week of July and the first week of August. Transplanting is another common theme during July as many plants are dormant and can be moved without worrying about disturbing them. So if you are looking for a change of scenery or just to update the overall look and feel of your garden, now is an ideal time.

To Do

1. Winter gardening for herbs and veggies:

If you want a good crop of herbs and vegetables in winter then raised beds are a good idea as their soil temperature is higher. Greenhouses and tunnels are recommended in areas with extreme temperature. Only

grow vegetables that do well in cooler conditions. Sow seeds of carrots, radishes, broad beans and beetroot until the end of August

2. Prune:

It's a wonder that July has not been renamed pru-ly in south African circles, because a consistent theme this month, countywide, pruning. This is an especially true for fruit trees and roses, but also any deciduous shrubs that may be in need of a trim. Remember to shred all your cuttings and pop them onto the compost heap that you've almost certainly already started, haven't you?

It's important for you to perform the process now and don't delay it until the flowering is done.

3. Improve the layout:

As you can see the bones of the garden, consider possible design changes you could make. In dry areas, winter is the ideal time to build erect a pergola or archway, redo the paths and redesign the beds. Take the opportunity to level sloping, uneven areas and build steps to link different levels.

4. Feeding and mulching:

Do this right after pruning. Remove the annuals that have finished flowering then work compost and organic pellets into the beds. If the soil drains well, work these lightly into the top 3-5 cm. If the soil is clay or rocky, dig in compost to at least a forks depth, but take care not to disturb the roots of plants.

The wonderful surprise

A Lesser Striped Swallow Nest

In October last year as soon as the border restrictions had been lifted, I went on a lovely trip of our country which was a tremendous experience after having been cooped up at home for a long time because of COVID.

A trip through the Karoo

My trip took me through the Karoo where I visited Kenhardt and Brandvlei . I remember when I first came to South Africa people told me that this was the most boring and ugly area imaginable and that it was best to go through it as fast as possible. However, I have always loved the Karoo and have made several trips there. The birdlife of various lark and Pipits is very good and I have learned that the best way to study them is to stop by cement dams where they come to drink. Leaving the Karoo behind and going through Calvinia and Nieuwoudtville I was greeted by the most beautiful display of Spring flowers. This almost lasted all the way to Lambert's Bay with its Gannet Colony which is thriving again after the beautiful hide that had been vandalised has been rebuilt. The road along the WestCoast all the way to Langebaan stopping at places like Rocherpan Bird Sanctuary is always an absolute pleasure.

After a brief stay at Somerset West I started the journey back home along the Garden Route and the Karoo National Park. Wonderful to be reminded all the time what a beautiful country we live in.

A wonderful surprise waiting for me at home

When I came home there was a wonderful surprise waiting for me. A pair of Lesser Striped Swallows were starting to build their nest on my patio. They were very

tame and would sit on one of the patio chairs completely unperturbed while I had my breakfast. Both the male and female would take turns building.

Capturing it on video

Now for the first time I was able to make a complete video of the way these swallows build their nest. Collecting mud from a dam

not very far away they would take small mud pellets in their beaks and guided by a strange intricate and inexplicable instinct carefully place these in position. When they start building and we already know what the final result will look like it seems like an impossible task but they simply carry on and soon it becomes clear that these little birds know exactly what they are doing.

How they built the nest

First they constructed a bowl like shape which enabled them both to sit inside and build. When this was done I wondered if they slept in this bowl during the night. I decided to check this so I waited until it was completely dark and took a flash photograph of the nest. I was pleasantly surprised to see the two swallows on the nest looking very annoyed to have been woken up.

The fact that they went quite far to fetch mud worried me a little. I thought I could make it easier for them by providing a source of mud closer to home.

I mixed soil and water in a large pan and it looked exactly like the mud that they collected. I placed the pan on the patio table right in front of the chair they used to sit on but they ignored it. I know that if I had put the mud on my lawn they would have taken it because once it rained and they walked on the grass and looked for mud. But they ignored my effort because mud is not supposed to be served in a pan on a table.

Raising a family

They stopped building on the 1st of November and I looked forward to them feeding andraising the chicks. I knew that the eggs would take 21 days to hatch and I took some shots of the swallows as they carried food in and removed droppings out of the nest but something was wrong.

Instead of the expected 21 days for the chicks to hatch I was surprised on the 10th of November by three chicks sitting with the adults on the chair ready to fly out.

It made me wonder if they already had eggs while they were still building.

They spent a few days still sleeping in the nest at night but flying out with the parents every morning and then another thing happened! A pair of Greater Striped Swallows suddenly appeared and started building their own nest by simply attaching their mud pellets to the existing nest. They continued building until it was time for them to migrate back to Central Africa.

So now I have this one and a half nest on my patio and eagerly await the return of the two pairs of different swallows next Spring. Will the Greater Striped continue building? Will the Lesser Striped raise another brood? Will they all live in perfect harmony?





Undesirable Tree of the Month:

Beefwood

Casuarina Cuminghamiana

Invasive trees

The Beefwood originates from Eastern Australia and have been planted in South Africa for more than a century. They unfortunately have become a huge problem in the Western Cape, Kwazulu Natal, Limpopo and Mpumalanga Provinces. This tree resembles a Pine tree with its upright growth reaching a height of approximately 30 metres. Beefwood trees carry needles as well as cones that disperse its seeds to form dense stands of saplings around the "mother plant".

These stands can reduce water flow of rivers when they grow along water courses. Therefore, "water hungry" is a good description for the Beefwood.

We would strongly recommend eradication of this tree from suburban gardens.

Good replacement trees


Good replacement trees are the various South African Yellowwoods. Consider the Common Yellowwood – Podocarpus latifolius or Outeniqua Yellowwood – Podocarpus Falcatus.

Both are still slender growing trees. If your garden is on the smaller side, consider Henkels Yellowwood – Podocarpus Henkeli, as it is slower growing and only reaches about a third of the height of the other trees.

Little Bittern

Ixobrychus minutus

This shy bird is resident on our estate but is seldom observed as it is a retiring species, hiding out in dense reedbeds. When seen the small size in relation to other herons and bittern species becomes evident.

The male has a green-black crown with elongated feathers forming a modest crest. The chin and throat are white with a buff centre and the back and tail is greenish black. The flight feathers show conspicuous buff white wing patches. The undersides are buff white with minimal brown streaking that is variable among individuals. The female is smaller and duller in colour with brown striped underparts.

The flight is rapid for a heron, flying with guick, shallow, clipped wing beats, legs dangling, often dropping into cover. Freshwater wetlands having thick herbaceous vegetation with trees or bushes interspersed nearby are the favoured habitat preference. There are not many localities in the estate with that vegetation but the bird has been found at the dams at Sawgrass and some of the larger dams bordering the golf course that have dense reeds. An interesting aspect of this bird is that when alarmed it assumes the "Bittern Posture" with its bill pointing skywards, a pose designed to avoid detection. The species nests in thick vegetation especially near open water pools. The nest is made of stems of herbaceous vegetation, lined with finer material. 3-4 eggs are laid in the spring and summer months.

The Little Bittern feeds by walking slowly at the water edge, stalking prey from the ground, or





more characteristically from a perch, stabbing prey items that it sees. It is primarily crepuscular over much of its range (mostly active at dawn and dusk), but feeds at night and also at times during the day. The diet is varied; fish, frogs and tadpoles, small reptiles, eggs and young birds, worms, insects such as crickets, grasshoppers, caterpillars, water bugs, beetles.

The Little Bittern is a bird of dense marsh vegetation, in which it feeds and nests. Since it forages in the typical bittern manner of walking and standing on marsh plants or branches adjacent to dams and ponds it is incumbent upon us to ensure that this important habitat is preserved in the estate. It is a distinctive, small heron, and the tell-tale buffy patches in the flight feathers will tell you that you are onto this species!

Cryptocurrencies – A Summary

Over the past few months, we have discussed several topics in the cryptocurrency industry. **Let's recap**.

What is Bitcoin?

Bitcoin is a digital currency that is designed for an internet-based society. It can be transacted directly between two parties, with no middleman such as a bank required. As such, it cannot be controlled by any government or organisation, therefore existing as a borderless financial system. Bitcoin can be used as money to pay for things like property or groceries, it can be traded for other cryptocurrencies or Dollars, Pounds and Rands, or it can be held as an investment. The base technology behind Bitcoin is called blockchain technology.

How do I buy, spend, accept or store cryptocurrencies?

To buy Bitcoin and other cryptocurrencies like Ethereum, Melon is a convenient way to purchase the top crypto in one bundle. You can also buy and trade cryptocurrencies on crypto exchanges like VALR. To spend, accept or store crypto, simply download one of the many wallets that can be found in your app store, like Exodus. Sending and receiving is done using crypto addresses (similar to bank account numbers) that are automatically generated when the wallet is first created.

Why are cryptocurrencies so volatile?

Because the cryptocurrency industry is so young, there is a lack of regulation in the industry. This creates uncertainty, and, together with a surge in demand and influence by prominent people like Elon Musk, crypto prices tend to change very quickly. While some

people invest in cryptocurrencies for the long term, traders fuel this volatility by speculating on insane price predictions – akin to gambling.

Why should I consider an investment in cryptocurrencies?

From a technological and social perspective, cryptocurrencies are beginning to challenge the global financial system. As society evolves, so should the way in which we transact with one another. Bitcoin and other cryptocurrencies may not replace the financial system, but they certainly are a stepping stone in the evolution of money. We may one day find ourselves in a world where transacting in cryptocurrencies become as synonymous as using the internet. For these reasons, it is important to at the very least be aware of a technology that could very well change our lives.

Some key benefits of cryptocurrencies include

- Accessibility unlike banks, crypto transactions happen around the world 24/7.
- Control access and backup your money anywhere in the world without needing to ask for permission.
- Scarcity cryptocurrencies like Bitcoin are limited in supply, just like gold, which has traditionally been used as a store of value.


