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

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The POPI Act

The Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA) provides for certain conditions that companies need to follow in order to process personal information lawfully.

The purpose of the Act is to ensure that personal information is secure. It is there to protect individuals against identity theft, fraud and other breaches of identity fraud of their personal information. Failure to comply with the requirements of the POPI Act could have dire consequences. Although one cannot and shouldn't shy away from the legal aspects of the Act, POPIA should be seen as an opportunity to manage information better and improve the relevant business processes.

There are key requirements under the POPI Act:

- 1. Appoint an Information Officer responsible for the POPIA compliance. The officer will deal with any privacy requests made to the organization and cooperate with the Information Regulator.
- 2. Identify the lawful basis of collection and use of all personal information. Organizations can process personal information only on a lawful basis. The processing of information should be relevant and not excessive.
- 3. Respond to data subjects' data access and rectification requests. Under the POPIA, data subjects have the right to access their data and inquire about third parties who have access to the information.

- 4. Notify security compromises as soon as reasonably possible. POPIA requires any organization to inform the Regulator of any security compromises where there are reasonable grounds to believe that personal information has been accessed by an unauthorized person.
- Have a written contract with the data operator. POPIA requires organizations to have a written contract with the operator or data processor to ensure that the operator will establish and maintain security measures for the protection of personal information.
- Ensure adequate level of protection in cases of cross border data transfer. An organization cannot transfer personal information to a third party in a foreign country unless certain conditions are fulfilled.

The Regulator may inspect businesses and any third party can report non-compliance. If a business is found non-compliant by the Regulator, the person responsible for the contravention, or the information Officer can be fined to a maximum of R10 000 000.00 (Ten Million Rand), or could face imprisonment for up to 10 years. It is therefore of utmost importance to familiarize yourself with the POPI Act to ensure that your business is compliant.

As a seller you have a few things to consider to ensure a smooth transaction. If you are behind in bond payments or, other debts pertaining to your property, it is important to share your situation with the agent. This will prepare the agent to assist you and navigate the best way forward. The seller has to pay 3-4 months of rates, taxes and levies up front. This can impact on your cash flow. Rather be prepared or, let the agent know if there is a problem. You will also have to advise the bank of your intention to sell so that they have notice to cancel your bond. There is a bond cancellation fee but, you do want to avoid paying additional interest penalties, so advise your bank in writing when you do to market. The defect list is important as whilst properties are sold "voetstoots" in South Africa, you still have an obligation to be honest with any defects you may have with your home. This better prepares your buyer to plan for any additional costs they may incur on the property. Try and hand the home over to the new buyer clean and in a well maintained state, this just leaves a better impression on the buyer which is important. The smoother the process, the better the relationship, for dealing with any issues that may arise.

The Seven Elements of Design

- and how to use them in your interiors: PART 1

They are the key to every successful scheme.

The seven elements of design are designed to help you balance an interior scheme so that the finished look is aesthetically pleasing, as well as functional. Design is a science as well as an art. Addressing each of the elements that make up every design can enhance a room's best features, compensate for any flaws, and create an interior that satisfies the eye, the sense of touch, and fulfils its practical role.

What are the 7 elements of design?

The seven elements of design consider space, line, form, light, colour, texture, and pattern. A balance of these elements is vital to every scheme.

1. Space

'Space' refers to the distance between and around furniture and objects and their proportions within a room. Getting the balance within a room right relies on using both 'positive' and 'negative' space right.

Positive space is where the room's objects – such as a sofa and armchairs – are positioned, while negative space refers to the gaps in between, and includes circulation space for navigating through the room, as well as the areas left open to prevent the room from feeling cluttered.

An appropriate balance between the two is vital for a room to feel well laid-out. One with more negative space will feel more spacious, larger, and bigger – but too much negative space can also make a room feel under-furnished and impersonal. A room with too much positive space taken up can, on the other hand, feel crowded and over-furnished.

How to get this right? The beauty is very much in the eye of the beholder – if you find a cluttered room homely, using more negative space will suit you. However, as a general rule, thoroughfares in a room need to be at least 1 m wide, while gaps between, say, a sofa and a coffee table, is comfortable at around 50 cm.

2. Line

Both the structural features and the room's furnishings can create lines that profoundly influence the feel of the space, and they can also be employed to bring attention to a focal point. As well as horizontal and vertical, they can be dynamic.

Horizontal lines, such as those of tables, bring a sense of stability to an interior. They can also make a room feel wider. The vertical lines of the room come from features like windows and doors or a tall fireplace. They are prized for giving a feeling of freedom and can make a room seem taller. Choosing a tall piece of furniture, for example, can lead the eye upwards and visually heighten the room. In any scheme a balance between horizontal and vertical lines is essential.

Dynamic lines like diagonals, zigzags and curves could come from a feature such as a staircase, but

also can be created with tiling laid diagonally. They are eye-catching and they inject a scheme with energy.

3. Form


Form is shape, and that includes the shape of the room itself along with the objects within it, like furniture, artwork, and decorative accessories. These shapes might be geometric – those that have precise lines and angles – or natural – not just the irregular shapes of nature but curvaceous pieces.

Key with these forms is, once again, balance and natural shapes, which can bring softness to an interior in contrast to the stronger geometrics.

DNA Estate Maintenance Update

What a joy to have got through one of our coldest winters.

The nature team have all been hard at work throughout the difficult cold early morning extreme weather conditions, and with the anxiety of the Covid 19 news feeds and co-workers who had been hit by the outbreak, the troubled resent unrest in the Country mentally left everyone with a lot of anxieties. However, with a positive outlook and steering them on, the nature team came through with many excellent jobs accomplished and in good spirit.

Our Indigenous areas encouraged birds and small creatures to different areas looking for food, and testimony to this was all the beautiful photographs which were sent in by some of the residents, especially Geraldine Harris, who sent in the most wonderful bird pictures which were sighted in the

dam in front of her house in Saw Grass. We just love receiving all of your photos, captured at different times and places around the Estate, so keep them coming.

Maintenance

Cleaning of dams and sourroundings

Maintenance continues. The undermining at the top weir by the first dam was repaired by maintenance as best as possible, under the circumstances of not having the proper machinery to get into that area.

We removed the weeds along the banks of the dam on the west side and some of the reeds at the dam entry where we did a clean-up we removed hyacinth and further brush cutting where we could from the bank and shallow areas, as we could not get the barge into the low-lying water in the dam.

Dams were cleaned up and are looking reasonably good, the flushing out of the sewerage leak really saved the dams and helped tremendously with how they look to date.

Removal of sludge and hyacinth is ongoing as are the reeds and weeds. Shade grass, which was planted as a test, has grown well considering the cold, but now the ducks are eating the green looking grass, let us hope that the rains come shortly, so that the wild grass greens up soon, in order for my little lush green corner to survive.

The grassland around the sewer leak by the third dam, has been cleaned up, trees lifted, and rubbish removed, grassland on that eastern boundary wall area have all been cleaned and is all ready for the new growth.

The unsightly area in Saw Grass has finally been cleared, trees were lifted, dead wood taken out, lots of weeds and rubbish were also removed, a huge improvement and long overdue clean up.

With the coming rains the grass in this area, will now grow properly and will all look much neater and well maintained along that walking path. The area by the leaking sewer leak has also been weeded and cleaned, trees lifted and grass cut on the eastern boundary wall.

All Saw Grass Dams are now looking good, Hyacinth and sludge have been removed off the dam surface. Trees donated by Geraldine, thank you have been planted on the eastern boundary side, at the last dam.

Montague/Bentwood area

The Montague/Bentwood area, needed some attention again in the areas in front of the houses in that grassland area, and although we had maintained that area we had to go back and lift some of the trees, weed and do some brush cutting. The bank at the 4th hole has also been weeded and the trees donated by Geraldine, will be planted alongside both step areas.

Grassland and Poplar March

Grassland along the 4th fairway has been cut, trees lifted, and aloes moved to the end of that bed which will be more visible on the corner. Poplar Marsh some of the flower beds have been re planted and sorted. No chip bark is available, as the correct size for paths is presently unavailable, so all paths needing chip bark are on hold.

Olivia Walk

Olive Walk is OK, grasslands at the 6th were cut and trees have been lifted, gullies weeded, the

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paths are raked most Fridays. It is disappointing that cyclists are using Olive Walk as a cycling track, which is not good, this is one of our very special nature trail paths, where small creatures and birdlife can be seen, the lack of respect for our Nature sensitive areas the last couple of years, is a bit worrying, considering the amount of work that goes into preserving them for future generations to enjoy. The cycle tracks also eliminate the animal spoor which is nice to see in the sand.

Rocky Ridge

Rocky Ridge the same thing the lack of respect for this beautiful rocky pristine sensitive area is quite upsetting, papers, tins and bike tracks going down into this now well warn rocky path trail, disappointing to say the least.

Aloes on that rocky ridge grassland are a lovely sight and you can be sure to see a sun bird if you take the time to walk this lovely area. Such a pity that this area won't be burnt again this year, as this would have stimulated the new growth of some really beautiful little wildflowers, which happen to grace this rocky ridge. Wild hare and Porcupine use this area quite a lot, but disappointing to see the bike tracks within this area as well.

Wetland Area and Paths

Our Wetland area is looking good, grasslands have been trimmed throughout the season to keep the dam areas visible for the sightings of waders and water birds and small creatures that frequent these little dam areas. We have spotted a couple of malachite kingfishers on 2 different occasions sitting on the Acacia in the middle of the top dam which was nice, I am looking forward to the day I see some Bee Eaters in the bank.

All the grasslands up in that area and along the 7th fairway have been weeded a couple of times and a lot of weeding has been done in Bush Baby Area where deep in the bush we found a lot of cactus and moth catchers. The edging brick along

the 12th fairway has also been brush cut and trees lifted along the edge.

The Path from Butterfly up to Highgate Dam was brush cut and weeded, plus the pine needles underneath the pine trees where raked and parts of the gardens are being replanted in Butterfly.

16th area, is OK but the guys will be giving it some attention over the next weeks, as some plants were knocked by frost.

Buffalo Thorn and Trent Stream Walks

Buffalo Thorn and Trent Stream Walks are fine, with regular clean-up been done.

Next up on the list

Our Nature Team will be heading into the 10th Fairway bush area soon, which runs along the river in the vicinity of the old Pump House, there are numerous moth catchers popping up, a Wattle tree which needs to be removed and cut down, lots of weeds and rubbish in that grassland, which is needing some attention and cutting.

The walk/cycle track now runs all along that area which is an extension of Cormorant River Walk and is now a well-used path along the 17th and 18th fairways along the river below the Golf Driving range to this old pump house, all the more reason for bike riders to not ride in our nature sensitive areas, as there are enough riding areas to use around the estate other than our sensitive areas?

Highgate Upgrade (above)

A lovely upgrade has just been completed at Highgate Dam area, this a huge area, which Sean from Turfnet and I have been wanting to do for many years. The grass had to be removed and the soil banks had to be dug over and all of the areas had to be prepared with compost, then planted. This is from Highgate Dam meandering all the way down over the bridge and down to the junction at Honiton Drive and Wadsworth Place. The lovely upgrade has made a huge improvement in this area, well done to Dube, nature and maintenance, Thabo's team for the stone pitching work and fixing of the bridge, in that area.

Walking

It is quite a worry to see so many people walking along the golf course fairways, with young kids in prams or just young kids walking on their own. Residents be aware of the dangers of this, the dangers of the speed of those balls are very serious.

DNA Booklet

Spring is here - Why not take a walk along the nature trails. Each household should have received our DNA booklet which has all the trails and bird and tree life which can be marked off in the booklet when you take a walk. If anyone did not receive a booklet, you can get one from the Estate office.

That is all from me, we are now approaching our busy rainy season.



It's Spring Time!

September is here, and there's plenty to be done while you're outside enjoying the beginning of Spring. Harvesting crops will keep you busy this month. And there's plenty of work to do tidying and maintaining plants and equipment.

Jobs to do in the garden this month

- 1. Divide your herbaceous perennials. This will keep your plants healthy and vigorous year after year and multiply your stock.
- Net ponds now before Spring gets underway to get them clean for the coming warm summer season.
- 3. Clean out greenhouses ahead of Spring and plant up bare areas for the growing season.
- Plant spring-flowering bulbs now, such as daffodils, crocus and hyacinths, for glorious colour next season.
- Scarify, top-dress and fertilize your lawn with a good quality compost and organic fertilizer, available from Turfnet.

In the flower garden

Continue to feed and deadhead flowers and shrubs.

Keep deadheading annuals and perennials.

Prune back flowering shrubs such as roses, Hydrangeas etc.

In the fruit garden

Tidy up your strawberry plants and clear away used straw, as this will harbor pests and diseases over summer.

Pick ripe apples, to test when they're ripe, gently lift them in the palm of your hand or give them a gentle pull – they should come away easily.

Mow long grass under fruit trees to make it easier to spot windfall fruits.

Cut back the fruited canes of your summer raspberries, if you haven't already, leaving the new green canes for next year's crop. Tie in next year's raspberry canes to support wires or fencing.



Southern Red Bishop

Euplectes orix

As we approach the end of our long winter, we should turn our attention to some of our more colourful and cheerful birds that exhibit their best plumage and displays in the summer months.

One such bird is the Southern Red Bishop. The breeding male in his bright red and black plumage is unmistakable. Females, non-breeding males and young birds are dull coloured and can be difficult to distinguish from other bishops and widowbirds. It is important to note that the males have an eclipse plumage that is only seen in summer, and birds in their non-breeding winter plumage will often form mixed flocks with other seed eating birds, and then you need to put your identification skills to the test!

These birds feed mainly on seeds, but will also feed on insects in summer and when feeding their young. Many different plants producing seeds have been recorded and they are quick to exploit a food source that is discovered. In areas like Dainfern where there are many garden feeders they will readily take bird seed. Chicks are fed on arthropods including dragonflies, beetles, caterpillars and spiders.

Seldom found far from water and nesting chiefly in reedbeds, the Southern Red Bishop is polygynous, with several females nesting in a male's territory at any one time, and male birds will pair with several different females in a season. It is colonial, with colonies of several hundred nests in reeds at times. In Dainfern




Male (left) and Female (right) Southern Red Bishops

there are good concentrations of these birds in the small dams we have on the estate that have dense reeds associated with them. The nest is an oval, with a side entrance under a porch near the top. It is tightly woven of thin strips of reed or grass blades, and lined with plant down and grass seed heads. The nest is built by the male and may be completed in a single day, but usually takes 2-3 days. The female adds lining to the inside of the nest, starting just after the eggs are laid. The average clutch size is 3 eggs, and the eggs are a distinctive pale bluish-green to turquoise, sometimes with a few dark spots. All the incubation and rearing of the young is undertaken by the female with no assistance from the male. If the nest is threatened by predators such as snakes however, or if there are parasitic species such as the Diederick Cuckoo about, then males will often band together to try to drive the threat away.

This species has increased in numbers in different parts of the country due to the building of dams and irrigation canals, and the expansion of seed crops. Numbers are reduced, however, where wetlands are drained. It is another example of a regular and very welcome feathered resident in Dainfern and will always persevere as long as we maintain our wetland areas in the estate and manage the reedbeds carefully.

But all the hard work will be worth it, as it allows us to continue the vital work of rescuing, rehabilitating and releasing the wildlife on your doorstep."


"We're thrilled to be expanding our Chartwell campus to include Grade R. There is a desperate

CAMBRIDGE A LEVELS

ainfern College is a proudly South African school which also places huge emphasis on the value of internationalism. Since inception in 1997, the College has offered the IEB National Senior Certificate ('matric') as its exit examination, and the first Grade 12 cohort wrote matric in 2001. To meet university entrance requirements in South Africa, all Cambridge students are required to take Mathematics, English Language and a second South African language in addition to three or four elective subjects. Elective subjects currently offered include Biology. Chemistry. Physics, Geography and History.

Cambridge students choose between Afrikaans and isiZulu as their second language. This is only required to be at IGCSE level, which is similar to the Grade 10 level of proficiency. Students are therefore able to write their IGCSE language exam at the end of Grade 10, allowing them to concentrate fully on their other Cambridge subjects in Grades 11 and 12.

This was the first time that students at Dainfern College had written the A Level examinations and they did not disappoint. Hamza achieved the top AS Level Physics mark in South Africa amongst the students writing the vear-end examination in 2020 - a phenomenal achievement.





What are blockchains

In the cryptocurrency world, the word "blockchain" is often thrown around as something that will revolutionise technology and the internet. What is a blockchain, and are they really that powerful?

A blockchain is simply a type of database

All computer systems use databases, whether it be in the form of a hard drive or flash drive, or online like Google Drive or Apple iCloud. Databases are used to store information. With traditional databases, information can be added, edited or deleted, and in worse situations, corrupted.

Blockchains are unique in that information added to them can never be changed. This is ideal for financial systems where an accurate transaction history always needs to be maintained, such as with cryptocurrencies. Blockchains are also decentralised, meaning there isn't a central, master copy of information as with banks. Anybody can download a copy of a blockchain and verify the information stored in it. Because anybody can verify this information, it makes it almost impossible for someone to try and cheat. This is what makes blockchains incredibly powerful.

Blockchains record the movement of funds

Ultimately, when it comes to cryptocurrencies, blockchains are simply accounting databases. They keep track of transactions between accounts. A blockchain is literally a chain of blocks, and each block contains a group of transactions that are processed at the same time. Each block is linked to the next in such a way that by changing any transaction in history, it immediately breaks a link in the chain and signals that something fraudulent has happened. That fraudulent transaction then gets rejected by everyone.

Blockchains in other industries

Because of this immutable nature of blockchains, they are now being explored for use in virtually every other industry. In real estate, blockchains are being used to record the ownership (and change of ownership) of property efficiently and transparently. Tamper-proof medical histories and academic certificates are being stored on blockchains according to issuer, receiver,

and issuance date. Even digital artwork is being traded and stored on blockchains.

Blockchains still have a ways to go

Yes, blockchains really are that powerful. Yet, as with any technology, there are also drawbacks. Adding information to a blockchain is a slow process, so building websites such as Amazon, which has millions of users every hour, is not a good idea. Privacy is also an issue, as most blockchains are open to the public. Private blockchains do exist, but they have shown far less potential than public blockchains. Lastly, unlike the internet, there isn't just one blockchain. Most cryptocurrencies run on their own blockchain with unique characteristics, so the use of a particular blockchain is dependent on the task at hand.

To sum it up

Thus far, blockchains have largely been overhyped in their ability to change the way that the world works outside of finance. While they most certainly have shown potential for financial systems and are an absolute necessity for decentralised cryptocurrencies, we are yet to see global acceptance of them in other industries.
