

## ELECTRICAL COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE

## Responsibilities for the homeowner regarding the electrical compliance certificate when selling.

When selling your property, it is a requirement that you obtain an electrical compliance certificate. In this article we are going to briefly discuss a few questions that we are regularly asked. The Occupational Health and Safety Act ("OHSA") places the onus on every user or lessor of a property, to ensure that the property's electrical installation does not pose a threat to any person or animal on the premises.

### 1. Who can issue a Certificate of Compliance ("COC")?

Only a registered person may issue a COC after inspecting and testing the electrical installation. Should any fault or defect be found, the latter must be rectified prior to the issuing of the COC. It is always best to use a member of the ECA(SA) to ensure that the electrical contractor is a registered person. A registered person is an electrical tester who is registered with the Department of Employment and Labour.

2. How long does it take for an electrical contractor to inspect and test a property in order to issue a COC?

This is all dependent on the size of the installation

and if any faults or defects are found on the property. Take caution when an electrical contractor issues a COC in 30 minutes. Remember, only a registered person may legally issue a COC.

#### 3. How long is a COC valid for?

The Electrical Installation Regulations state that a Certificate of Compliance is valid for two years for purposes of transfer.

 You have a COC but the installation is not functioning properly. What should you do?

It is important to bear in mind that the COC and Test Report certify the safety of the installation and the electrical wiring. It does not include the replacing of light bulbs or fixing of a broken stove for example. It certifies that everything is safe and the COC and Test Report is valid.

### 5. Do you need a COC for your electric fence?


A Electric Fence Certificate must be obtained when transferring your property. The Electric Fence Certificate must comply with the installation and material specifications.



of items you already have on hand. Think out of the box, use champagne coolers, and load up.

4. If you live in a large house go for multiple trees. Go for matching foliage over a mantel or mirror. We once styled a client's house for Christmas, and we placed a tree in every bedroom dressed just with warm white fairy lights. We realise this is nothing radical in terms of decoration tips. But what made it work so beautifully was the constant repetition.





- 5. Fairy lights, these should not just be reserved for the tree(s) Use them on mantelpieces, stairways, over mirrors, around bedposts, in foliage, under conches and in bowls. Always use the same lights everywhere, warm white (no flashing). When the house is lit with fairy lights it is amazing how it becomes magical. For extra impact use mirrors, and not just mirrors that are hung on the wall. Try plain mirrors on table and sideboard surfaces to reflect the light for magic overload.
- 6. If you have no room for a tree or you do not have a mantelpiece, use a fallen branch. Hang it from the ceiling, over a modern 'hole in the wall' fireplace, above the Christmas lunch table, above the front door, on a plain wall, over a mirror – the list goes on. String it with fairy lights, glass baubles, small gifts. It is staggering how versatile a simple brown branch can be.

## Keep things neutral and natural, adding trends in colour or texture

- 7. For an earthy, natural feel, use pinecones, ferns, and ivy to create rustic, seasonal touches around the home
- Giving the children their own separate tree to decorate solves the problem of what to do with all those inherited. gifted, sentimental

decorations. Along with helping them make their advent calendars for each other (choose a different theme every year).

9. When choosing flowers, fauna and foliage, opt for a mass of one variety rather than a little of a lot of different varieties. Go for a different main flower every year. Orchids, heathers, simple gyp are favourites.

A wreath made from seasonal flowers, foliage and twinkling fairy lights will create impact and a burst of wonderful scent. Hang on the wall behind a table laden with nibbles and drinks to welcome guests

10. Our final tip, which is more of a general design tip and not exclusive to decorating for the holiday season: whenever we design a home, we try and find a place for what we call a central table. This is usually referred to as a library table and can be placed anywhere in the house albeit a hallway or centrally located room is preferable. What we love about library tables is that you can dress them seasonally. At



Christmas they call out for another tree; at Spring, huge vessels with spring blooms; at family birthdays, loaded with cards and gifts. If you only have the time or inclination for just one project, make it this one. It is the perfect considered and effective way to set the tone for whatever the season.

## Taking care of your running shoes

With the first Spring rains having hit Gauteng over the past few weeks, getting your shoes all muddy and grungy, how exactly do you clean them while maintaining their longevity?

Regular cleaning of your running shoes helps to maintain the life and appearance of the uppers. Dry your shoes naturally in a well-ventilated place to remove the excess moisture. It helps to scrunch up some toilet/news paper and leave this in the shoes for an hour or 3 to absorb any excess moisture. You can remove the shoes sock liner to improve ventilation. Brush any excess crud off to aid the drying process. Drying the shoes in a dryer causes damage to the mid-sole and affects the cushioning. Remove the laces before cleaning. Use a toothbrush to clean the crevices.

 You can clean them with water, but please don't put them in a washing machine. Very often glues used in the manufacturing process are water soluble, and the shoe may shrink or have its shape deformed. Use mild

soap, like Sunlight Liquid foam, to clean your shoes, or any of the foams available from sports stores.

You should not dry shoes using a heat source, as it can break down or harden the EVA (ethyl vinyl acetate), of the midsole.

The life span for most running shoes depend on how long and how you use them. Preferably use two pairs and wear them on alternate days allowing each pair to dry out. To extend the life of your shoes, loosen the laces before taking them off your feet. Depending on your weight, the terrain run on and average length of your runs/walks you should be able to get between 700 and 1000km on a good pair of shoes. Entry level shoes won't give you much more than 500km.

## **Gardening Tips**

#### To keep your garden looking at ites best

Usually by December, your garden will be in full glorious bloom. Here are some tips to help keep your garden looking at its best.

#### Garden moist:

With the heat that generally accompanies December, the most important task is to ensure that your garden is getting enough moisture. If Mother Nature is not supplying you with enough water (rain), you're going to have to do it yourself. Water your plants in the garden with a sprinkler for about 40 minutes every 3-4 days. Do not water every day. The roots need to be in moist soil, but the bulbs above them want to dry out slightly between watering. As soil in pots dries out quicker, water bulbs in pots every two days.

#### **Protection:**

When it comes to protecting your garden, contour compost is the gardener's first line of defense. Contour compost keeps the soil cool, combats evaporation and protects tender new roots, promoting healthier plants. Contour Compost: if you are using this product has bark chips which reduces reflected light which reduces ambient temperature, which reduces the moisture lost through transpiration, which reduces watering etc. this also helps control weeds because it cuts out light to the soil's surface, inhibiting seeds germination.

Pinch out dead flowers from annuals and fertilize with an organic 3:1:5 or a liquid fertilizer. Fill gaps in beds and hanging baskets with annuals and water very well. Annuals in colour bags are the perfect way to quickly spruce up your beds in time for Christmas entertainment. In shady areas and on patios add a dash of colour with Impatiens, New Guinea Impatiens, Coleus, Begonias and Hypoestes. The choice for sunny areas is more varied – choose your favourite from Dianthus, Lobelias, Petunias, Salvias, Celosias, Marigolds, Gazanias, Zinnias, Alyssum and many more.

Going away this month. Here are some strategies for helping your garden survive the holidays:

- Move plants in pots and hanging baskets out of direct sun.
- Mow your lawn and water it well. Postpone feeding your lawn until you return.
- Mulch flowerbeds.

## **Snakes of the Pilansberg**

Some years ago I made a video of the Pilanesberg Game Reserve which took just more than a year to make. It dealt with its early history, vulcanic eruptions, animals, insects, birds and snakes.

#### **Two Black Mambas**

I had made friends with "The friends of Pilanesberg" who allowed me to use their camp site. I would wait until they had all left and then searched the camp site for snakes . Most of the snakes seen here were filmed there. I would catch the snakes and film them in a suitable area. Most of them were harmless.

My son phoned me one morning and asked where I was. He was at a conference at Sun City and had taken a drive through Pilanesberg the day before. I told him that I was camping at Manyane and he said "Take the main road toward Mankwe dam and turn right at the first opportunity. Drive for a while until you see a Shepherd's tree on your left. About ten meters to the right is a small shrub. Look very carefully and you'll see a Black Mamba inside that shrub."

I thought: "Sure the fastest snake in Africa is there waiting for me!." I went, located the shrub and looked very carefully through binoculars. I saw no sign of any snake, but there were some more shrubs further on and true enough I saw the mamba's head

in one of those. I put my camera on a tripod, opened the car door and slowly walked towards the snake. I thought that it would probably leave the shrub and move away. Perhaps I could put my camera down and film it. But the mamba was too fast for me. When I looked again it was moving away at tremendous speed. It's head was about a meter above the ground so it was guite a large specimen. I went back to the car and sat there for some time. Disappointed for not being able to film the snake but grateful for having seen such a beautiful sight.

I drove on and later that day I came across one of those small river crossings where I stopped for a while. Suddenly I could not believe my eyes!!!!!! There crawling along some rocks on the side a black mamba was making its way past the little stream. It was not as big as the one I saw before, but I had never seen any mambas at Pilansberg before and now I saw 2 in one day!!! I got guite a nice shot.

#### Boomslang


Snakes, lizards and other reptiles can not see their prey unless it moves. The Boomslang and the Bird Snake are exceptions. The Boomslang with it large eye and round pupils and the Bird Snake also known as Twig Snake or Vine Snake . This remarkable snake has keyhole shaped pupils giving it stereoscopic vision and so it can identify its prey even when it is immobile.

The Boomslang is normally quite docile and will only bite if provoked. Most bites occur when people handle them in captivity. The Bird Snake's poison has the same effect as the Boomslang. The first time I saw this

snake was in Wankie Game Reserve. There was a chicken wire fence outside my tent and it looked as if a branch from a tree was entwined in its holes. ## **Cape Weaver**

**Ploceus** capensis

In spring weavers come into focus once again when the males attain their breeding plumage and start building their hanging nests. Many a keen gardener has had branches on a favourite tree stripped of leaves as the male clears the way to make his nest more visible to attract a female. The weaver bird that is most often encountered in our estate is the Southern Masked Weaver. But a second less often seen bird that generally does not breed in gardens is the Cape Weaver, and this bird is also present on the estate in small numbers.

A large weaver, the Cape Weaver adult male in breeding plumage is bright yellow with varying amounts of orange-brown on the face, a black bill, and a pale eye. The female is olive, with a yellow throat and belly, brown eye, and pale horn bill. The male is in non-breeding plumage for a relatively short time when it resembles the female but is yellower below, and retains the pale eye.

This species generally inhabits open country with some trees and permanent water. In our estate it is confined to quieter reedbeds with adjacent trees. Birds often occur in flocks, and can form large roosts throughout the year, which may be shared with other weavers and associated species. An omnivorous species, its diet is pretty much equally split between arthropods and plant matter, especially seeds, fruit and nectar. It forages on the ground and in tree foliage, gleaning food from crevices in bark and hawking insects aerially.

A polygynous, territorial colonial nester, males may have up to 7 females in one breeding season, usually living together in colonies of about 2-20 males. Each builds multiple nests within a small territory, which

it vigorously defends against intruders. The nest is built solely by the male in about 7 days, consisting of a kidney-shaped, fully waterproof structure made of woven broad strips of grass or reeds. If the female accepts it the male builds a vertical entrance tunnel at the base, while she lines the interior with fine grass and feathers. It is typically attached to the tip of a tree branch, especially of a Eucalyptus or willow tree (as in our estate), or alternatively in a bank of Phragmites reeds or Typha capensis bulrushes.

The egg-laying season is from October-January in the summer rainfall areas, with 2-5 turquoise blue eggs, which are incubated solely by the female for about 13-14 days. The chicks are initially fed mainly by the female, but later the male takes a greater role in providing food; the young leave the nest at about 17 days old.

The Cape Weaver is a cheerful, colourful weaver that is worth looking for in the estate, as it differs from the more regular Southern Masked Weaver in summer plumage as it lacks the black mask. Look for the pale eye and characteristic orange mask that the male bird exhibits. It is a bird that adds to the great diversity of bird species that can be seen in and around the estate.

## Poinsettias for Christmas

Poinsettia plants are native to Central America, especially an area of southern Mexico known as 'Taxco del Alarcon' where they flower during the winter. The ancient Aztecs called them 'cuetlaxochitl'. The Aztecs had many uses for them including using the flowers (actually special types of leaves known as bracts rather than being flowers) to make a purple dye for clothes and cosmetics and the milky white sap was made into a medicine to treat fevers. (Today we call the sap latex!) The poinsettia was made widely known because of a man called Joel Roberts Poinsett (that's why we call them Poinsettia!). He was the first Ambassador from the USA to Mexico in 1825. Poinsett had some greenhouses on his plantations in South Carolina, and while visiting the Taxco area in 1828, he became very interested in the plants. He immediately sent some of the plants back to South Carolina, where he began growing the plants and sending them to friends and botanical gardens.

One of the friends he sent plants to was John Bartram of Philadelphia. At the first Philadelphia flower show, Robert Buist, a plants-man from Pennsylvania saw the flower and he was probably the first person to have sold the poinsettias under their botanical, or latin name, name 'Euphorbia pulcherrima' (it means, 'the most beautiful Euphorbia'). They were first sold as cut flowers. It was only in the early 1900s that they were sold as whole plants for landscaping and pot plants. The Ecke family from Southern California were one of, if not, the first to sell them as whole plants and they're still the main producer of the plants in the USA. It is thought that they became known as Poinsettia in the mid 1830s when people found out who had first brought them to America from Mexico.

#### There is an old Mexican legend about how Poinsettias and Christmas come together, it goes like this:

There was once a poor Mexican girl called Pepita who had no present to give the baby Jesus at the Christmas Eve Services. As Pepita walked to the chapel, sadly, her cousin



Pedro tried to cheer her up. 'Pepita', he said "I'm sure that even the smallest gift, given by someone who loves him will make Jesus Happy."

Pepita didn't know what she could give, so she picked a small handful of weeds from the roadside and made them into a a small bouquet. She felt embarrassed because she could only give this small present to Jesus. As she walked through the chapel to the altar, she remembered what Pedro had said. She began to feel better, knelt down and put the bouquet at the bottom of the nativity scene. Suddenly, the bouquet of weeds burst into bright red flowers, and everyone who saw them were sure they had seen a miracle. From that day on, the bright red flowers were known as the 'Flores de Noche Buena', or 'Flowers of the Holy Night'.

The shape of the poinsettia flower and leaves are sometimes thought as a symbol of the Star of Bethlehem which led the Wise Men to Jesus. The red coloured leaves symbolize the blood of Christ. The white leaves represent his purity.

The Poinsettia is also the national emblem of Madagascar.
