Invasive plants

The morning glory is rife at this time of the year, as abundant as the blackjack, moth catchers, and bug weed, which keep our weeders busy throughout the summer period.

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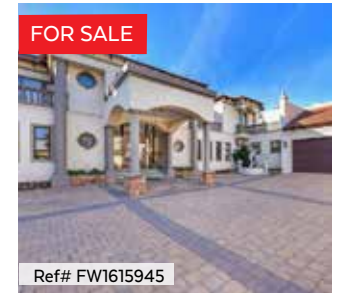

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Property returns demystified

What you need to know about your Return on Investment

When it comes to property investments, there are many myths and misunderstandings surrounding property returns. When looking at their property returns, many people fail to consider the comprehensive picture of their total return or return on investment (ROI). Very often, they only focus on a single aspect, which can be dangerous for property investors wanting long-term success.

Understanding your property investments' total returns has many benefits, including accurate evaluations of the financial viability of your investments and assessing risk and potential rewards. But to truly understand the ROI of your property investments, **it is crucial to consider the following two fundamental factors:**

1. Your Property Price Growth (Capital Appreciation Rate), and
2. The Net Rental Yield (Capitalisation Rate for Commercial Property).

The Property Price Growth or Capital Appreciation Rate

The Property Price Growth, also known as Capital Appreciation Rate, is the percentage with which the market value of a property grows annually. It is a crucial concept for you as a property investor to understand, and you should be able to use it to assess the potential profitability of investments. By understanding and analysing Property Price Growth, investors can make informed decisions and strategise for long-term financial success.

The Net Rental Yield or Capitalisation Rate for Commercial Property

Property Price Growth, however, is not the only return you get on your property investments. In addition to Property Price Growth, you also receive monthly rental income, whether you are renting the property yourself from one of your entities or leasing it to a third party.

The Net Rental Yield, or Capitalisation Rate for Commercial Property, calculates the return you receive on your property investments after all the property expenses have been paid.

The formula to calculate it is as follows:

Net Rental Yield = (Rental Income – Levies – Rates & Taxes – Rental Commission – Maintenance) x 12 / Purchase Price or Market Value

P.S. It is important to remember that your property has expenses associated with it, such as rental agency commission, levies, rates and taxes, and maintenance. One must also keep in mind that you might not always have a tenant, so there may be some vacancy costs to consider as well.

When making your projections, it is always best to be conservative and base your calculations on 10 months' rent, budgeting one month for potential vacancy and one month for maintenance. According to Lightstone, the average Property Price Growth (Capital Appreciate Rate) is currently in the vicinity of ±3% a year and if you invest wisely, you can get a property that can produce a Net Rental Yield of 6% to 8%!

This means your total return will be ±10% on a low-risk investment, which is excellent! A low-risk investment is one that keeps its value and slowly but surely increases its value and rental income, which should remain consistent and consistently grow.

It is also good to keep in mind that the average year-on-year Property Price Growth (Capital Appreciation Rate) for any consecutive 20 years in the last 50 years is significantly higher than the current growth rate. And since input costs, such as land prices, and material and labour costs, have increased significantly

(more than what property prices have increased), it is very possible for property prices to start growing at a higher rate in the future.

Also, this is not considering that your rental income grows every year (rental escalations) or that you can buy a property at a discount (below market value). Both of these factors can significantly increase the returns discussed above!

When interest rates are decent or low enough, and Property Price Growth or Net Rental Yields are strong, leverage or gearing becomes an attractive strategy to increase your returns significantly.

Leverage means using Other People's Money (OPM) or the bank's money. So, instead of using your funds to invest in property, you can borrow money from the bank to build a large asset base without using any of your own funds, or at least very little of your funds.

Leverage also amplifies the existing result, which means that it can turn a small positive return into a big positive return. But be warned; it can also turn a small negative return into a big negative return. So, proceed with caution!

It is thus important to ensure that the combination of your Property Price Growth and Net Rental Yield is more than you pay in interest. This is, of course, over the long term, as there are times when your interest rates are high while your returns are comparatively low.

By understanding the intricacies (and myths) of property returns, you can maximise your returns and reap the benefits of property investment over time. Just remember to consider the growth potential, rental income, and leveraging opportunities when appropriate, and you'll unlock the secrets of ROI on your property investments in no time at all!

GARDENING



March In The Garden

March is change over time in Gauteng, marking the start of the shift from summer to winter making it quite a tricky month for planting and even sometimes quite a wet month.

As the weather starts cooling don't forget to adjust your watering, especially any automatic systems, to use less of this precious commodity. Having said that, you should still water before 8am to lose as little moisture to evaporation as possible while still allowing the foliage enough time to dry off before nightfall, minimising the chance of your plants developing any fungal diseases.

If you didn't make use of mulch during the hotter months, you have no excuse now as mulching will prevent the soil from losing moisture on hot days in the warmer regions, help with protection on cold frosty nights in the colder ones and serve a dual purpose for our more temperate regions! Mulch is also great for suppressing weed growth, in case you needed yet another reason to get stuck in.

- Time to lift and divide agapanthus, wild iris, penstemon, campanula and asters. Cut them back, lift out, split up and replant into freshly composted soil.
- Sow Namaqualand daisies, sweet peas, poppies, primula, foxgloves, hollyhock, and larkspur. Don't be scared to sow the flowers that you love — success is guaranteed if you just follow the instructions on the seed packet.
- Sow seeds for new lawn grass, especially in colder areas where Shade Over and All Seasons Evergreen grow well.
- In the veggie garden, sow fast-growing greens like lettuce and spinach, and start preparing to plant winter crops like cabbage, cauliflower, parsnips, and broad beans.
- **Top tip:** Before it gets cold and the job becomes uncomfortable, clean out your water features. Check that your pump is clean and in good condition. You do not want to do this during the winter.
- Pull out spent annuals and old perennials and tidy up beds and borders. Prepare the soil to a spade's depth for seasonal annuals and bulbs: loosen the soil and mix in a good-quality compost and a little bonemeal.



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Understanding the role of conveyancing attorneys in South African property transfers

Keeping bugs away naturally

Whilst every gardener loves to watch the beautiful butterflies and bees in their garden, there are some bugs that are not so welcome, as they can cause havoc.

Spare a thought for the creatures in your garden and swap to natural pesticides and insecticides.

Insecticides are chemicals used to kill insects. Some insecticides are also dangerous to humans. Many insecticides can cause poisoning after being swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Symptoms may include eye tearing, coughing, heart problems.

Here are suggestions to make your own natural repellent which is environmentally friendly.

Repellent sprays

● Chilli spray:

Add 1 tablespoon of chilli powder to 1 quarter of water plus a few drops of a gentle liquid soap. Spray on the leaves of affected plants to keep the bugs away.

● Garlic spray:

Blend two whole bulbs of garlic with some water to make a paste. Let the paste rest overnight, then add to a spray bottle with 1 teaspoon of gentle soap. Top off with water, then spray on the affected plants.

Alternatively, let nature take its course and let the wildlife and birds do the job for you.

With any DIY insecticide, always test on a small area of the garden first to make sure the spray doesn't harm the plants. Wait a day after the test spray, then proceed if the plants are fine.



Rules for spraying

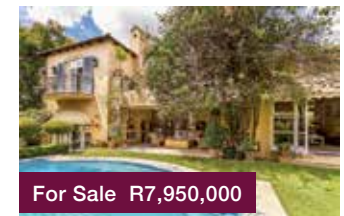
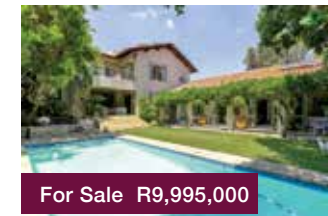
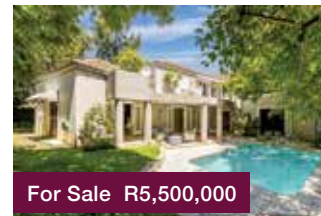
- Never apply any insecticide to a stressed plant. Avoid spraying burned leaves, and ensure all plants are well watered.
- Remove as many of the diseased leaves as possible before spraying. If the leaves still look healthy, treat them individually.
- It's best to apply either in the morning before the sun hits, or early evening when the sun has faded, to eliminate the chance of burns.
- Always wear gloves and a face mask when applying any pesticide in your garden, even a gentle one.
- Keep pets away from the area during application and until the insecticide has thoroughly dried, even if you use something like dish soap.
- Before applying to an entire plant, it is advisable to test spray a few leaves with the solution you have made, wait 48 hours, and inspect for damage. If the leaves are burned or browned, dilute your solution and run another test.

A Strange Animal in our garden

A few days ago my gardener, Jackson came to me with a very worried expression. **He told me that there was a "strange animal" in the garden and when he approached it it hissed at him.** From his description it sounded to me that it was a crocodile and he confirmed that it was definitely nothing else. He was supposed to cut some reeds in my fishpond but he said that he would only do that if I sat on a chair near to him with a rifle in my hands. I managed to pacify him saying that it was probably a leguaan which was harmless.

A few days later I saw this small leguaan making his way through the undergrowth and managed to take some photographs which I showed Jackson and he confirmed that this was the crocodile he had seen. We had a good laugh especially as this leguaan was only about 150 cm long.

But this incident reminded me of my own experience with leguaans many years ago.

The Witwatersrand Bird Club of which I was a member used to go camping at a beautiful area with fantastic bird life near Groblersdal. Every morning I would go for a walk along the Moses River and many leguaans would come running at high speed from the forest on the right and plunge into the river on the left. I never saw them at rest and I realised that it would be impossible to film them unless I could catch one. **But how?** I spoke to some friends who were very interested in lizards and had built up quite a selection. **How do I catch a leguaan?**

"Very easy, just grab him by the base of his tail and lift him up. He won't be able to do anything!" That sounded simple

enough but how could I come close enough to do that? Trying to catch one of those high speed creatures as they came running towards the water would be impossible.

But the answer came completely unexpected. My wife and I were camping at our favourite place when a one meter leguaan strolled into our campsite. When I went towards him he turned and ran at great speed. As I ran after him he went up a tree but made the mistake of going sideways at the first branch which bent downwards towards me and I was able to grab him. By the base of the tail of course and I was relieved to see that my friends had been right. He could not do anything! I placed him in a large cardboard box. I had a friend, Mel Field coming the next day and he could help me with the filming.

We did not get much sleep that night as there was much noise coming from the cardboard box much to my wife's annoyance but Mel Field arrived early and we went to the river where I set up the camera and when everything was ready he let the leguaan out of the box. I expected it to run for the river but instead it took a slow walk and I could film it with all the time in the world!

After this I caught quite a few other leguaans. I got the reputation at the campsite that when leguaans were found inside tents or underneath motor vehicles the owners should call me.

Many years later I was camping at Pilanesberg with my family. A very small leguaan was climbing up a tree and I wanted to catch it to show my granddaughters. As I went towards it quickly scrambled to the back of the tree so I put both arms around the tree in an effort to grab it. My right hand was spot on as I got hold of it by the base of its tail. My left hand was not as it got hold of my thumb and bit with all the strength in its tiny body. I could not believe how strong its bite was. When I squeezed it with my right hand it bit even harder and I probably thought that if any of the larger leguaans that I had caught had bitten me they could have bitten my thumb off.

So there I stood, unable to move with the thought "HAVE YOU HUGGED A TREE TODAY" Eventually I let go with my right hand. It stopped biting and I grabbed it again so I could show it to my granddaughters. They were not at all interested so it had all been for nothing.

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Birding DAINFERN

Red-winged Starling

Onychognathus morio



This is one of our more familiar birds and is present on Dainfern Estate throughout the year. With its iridescent black plumage the bird may not at first glance look like much, but the striking reddish-chestnut flight feathers are particularly noticeable when the bird flies and this is what gave rise to the common name of Red-winged Starling. The female bird, as shown in the photographs, has an ashy-grey head and upper body and is therefore easily discernible from the male. In our region there is no other starling species that can be confused with this one, as our other common resident, the Cape Glossy Starling, and the less common Pied Starling, have quite different features.

This starling, like most of its congeners, is an omnivorous species, being partial to fruits, berries, seeds and nectar from plants such as flowering aloes during winter. In addition, they will take invertebrates such as beetles and termite alates and are known to take bird nestlings and even scavenge on carrion. They have been known to perch on livestock in rural areas where they will feed on insects and even ticks that they come across. In urban areas like Dainfern they quickly learn to exploit the food put out on bird feeders and will readily feed on fruit and the bonemeal that you can obtain from your butcher.

The Red-winged Starling is essentially a bird that breeds in rocky gorges and cliffs and must have existed only in this habitat in historical times. However, they have adapted very well to man-made structures and today use natural ledges and crevices and the eaves of buildings to build their sparse nest which consists of twigs and grass. They lay 2-4 bright blue eggs that are spotted with brown in spring and early summer. As very aggressive and attentive parents they are known to attack other birds, domestic animals and even people in the vicinity of the nest.

The pleasant drawn-out whistle that this bird makes is very distinctive and is often uttered when it is perched in a prominent position on a building or on top of a tree. If you know this sound you will be drawn to this species in our Estate. It is always a pleasure to know a Red-winged Starling is in the area!

Choose a breed carefully

As often happens, there will be families contemplating introducing a new pet, and therefore a new dynamic, into the household. Whilst this is an exciting time, it is also our responsibility as owners to integrate them properly into the home (especially if there are existing animals) and, **above all else, ensure they will be able to meet the breed specific needs of that new pet.**

With the family's permission and to illustrate the above point, I would like to share their story. When I answered the client's call, I could hear desperation in her voice. The family lived on a beautiful plot with a chicken coup, peacocks, bunnies, lots of birdlife and a cat (that I never saw in the time I was consulting there). They had a lovely little girl, aged around 5 at the time, her grandparents had moved in with their two little Yorkies and were living upstairs. The gardener and his family also lived on site. The core family had always owned Great Danes as pets and understood the breed well. However, when



the one passed away, the husband decided to fulfill his longtime dream of owning a Husky. (Those residents who own Huskies will know exactly where I am heading...). They located a breeder in Durban and the beautiful 8-week-old, blue-eyed puppy arrived via road transport with a bag of unbranded food. Unbeknownst to them, this was the beginning of a nightmare for the owners, existing pets, the wildlife on their property, and not to mention the Husky herself. (I will call her Luna which is not her real name)

By the time I met them all, they were at their wits end. The grandparents kept their two little dogs permanently upstairs as Luna bullied them and refused to let them down the stairs, the little girl was traumatized by being knocked over, the peacocks never came down from the trees, chickens and bunnies had been killed and the very good-natured remaining Great Dane's legs were being used as chew toys. Luna was now six months old and was clearly doing whatever she wanted, mouthing people's arms with her sharp teeth, climbing all over the dining room table and placing mud over the lounge suite. All the furniture was covered up and the tension in the house was palpable. The client was frustrated and angry with her husband and everyone had become resentful of the dog. Not a good place for anyone to be in. This was a classic example of a Breed Mismatch.

Physically, the Husky is shaped to go fast, over long distances and pull sleds. They have an ideal size to weight ratio which maximizes their economy of movement. Their ability to keep up a high intensity burst is owing to their oxygen usage where their bodies' blood vessels can distribute continuous nutrients to wherever they are needed. (They have more hemoglobin than other breeds enabling them to store and release when necessary). The Husky breed therefore needs lots of exercise, it's their job to run and run – just being left on the large plot didn't provide what the dog required.

Notably, Huskies have a strong prey drive; displaying the full typical motor patterns required for survival of the breed in harsh conditions. These are innate, internally motivated and are hard wired into the animal. Once activated, they will follow through their chase of their prey and deliver a kill-bite. They are not being mean or nasty, they just can't help it! Placing Luna on a 3-acre plot with loads of wildlife was like putting a sugar crazed kid in a candy store. The wildlife she was consuming also affected her stomach badly and she had permanent diarrhea for which she was on medication.

Huskies have a double coat and as such need to cool themselves down in the heat. Luna loved cooling down in their fountain, but the owner didn't want her to get wet as she would bring in dirt and roll, lie and dry herself on the furniture. This created frustration for Luna as she needed to cool down but always got into trouble for doing so.

As I was leaving the premises after the first consultation, Luna ran under my parked car and refused to come out. Apparently, she would keep visitors hostage and did this on a regular basis. After the owner shouted, cajoled, and eventually came out with a treat, the dog came out. I observed that Luna was clever and at 6 months of age had managed to train her owner. It had become a game, and the negative attention was better than no attention. "Luna doesn't listen to any of us" the owner commented in a very exhausted voice.

At this stage, take a moment and ask yourself...Is my dog confused as to what I have instructed him to do? Does he respect me enough to listen to me? Am I showing good leadership? It can never be the animal's fault; the blame lies with us and how effectively we communicate with them. I noted that everyone (barring the husband) in the house had emotionally switched off to Luna. She was ignored and left to her own devices. She had to mentally stimulate herself and did so without any rules.

All animals, like children, need boundaries, guidance and need to learn manners. It helps them relax, become less anxious and be socially acceptable. We need to set them up for success in life. A kid left to do their own thing from a young age feels insecure. So do our animals.

Had this family delved into the breed of dog they wanted to buy they would not have found themselves in this position. Before I could work again with Luna, they had contacted Husky Rescue to rehome her after she killed a peacock in front of their little daughter who was naturally traumatized. It is so important to conduct proper research and not take the opinion of a couple of people or go by comments on social media. Just because Joe Bloggs had a Husky who was best friends with a chicken doesn't mean that your Husky will be. Look carefully and examine the shelter or reputation of the breeder. At what age was the puppy weaned? Were they socialized? Are they registered with a Kennel Club? Were the puppy's parents aggressive? Anxious? Scared? Confident? One cannot underestimate the power of genes. Hereditary behaviours are real and may even require pharmacological intervention.

Ask yourself the following before adopting:

1. Is my environment suitable for the incoming animal?
2. How likely is it to get on with your other animals?
3. How will I introduce them to the family?
4. What do I need to provide for the animal to live out what he was bred to do?
5. Will I be able to meet the breed requirements to provide a good quality of life?
6. Am I adopting a breed based on looks?
7. Have I researched the type of dog that is joining my family?
8. Will this breed fit into my lifestyle?
9. Can I manage and cope with the breed requirements?

These are important questions that seriously need to be considered before placing the animals in an environment which may set them (and the other members of the family) up for failure.

Please do not solely adopt an animal on his looks or on your own emotions as to what would be a "cool to have" or an "I've always wanted one" as these are life affecting decisions for you and your existing animals. Be rational, research the breed, their specific requirements and make sure your environment is right to give them the quality of life they deserve and become a loving addition to your family.

I am happy to report that Luna was rehomed to an active family and is a companion to another Husky. There are no other animals in the home.
