Maintenance

Maintenance continues behind the scenes and as always, our nature teams are hard at work continuously removing alien plants and cutting back the dead grasslands so that the sun can get into those rhizomes in order that we keep our grasslands healthy.

This has been completed in Olive Walk, Sawgrass, the 4th, and 6th areas, Poplar Marsh, 8th fairway, 9th fairway, caffa cut through. Next on the list is the Wetland area.

Weeding of invasives also needs to be carried out before the cutting of the grass. Thankfully the cold weather does slow down the weeds a bit, for us to catch up in areas like Bush Baby area, which we shall be tackling in the next few weeks.








Winter **Gardening**

HERBS AND VEGGIES

If you want a good crop of herbs and vegetables in winter, then raised beds are a good idea as their soil temperature is higher. Only grow vegetables that do well in cooler conditions.



Plan and prepare beds for spring vegetables. Enrich the soil quality by spreading a thick layer of good quality compost throughout the vegetable patch. If space allows, add to the nitrogen content by planting a green manure, like lucerne or clover now and digging it into the soil when it starts to flower. Plant another batch of cabbage, Asian greens, Swiss Chard, carrots, radish, and lettuce and do a last sowing of peas.



ANIMATED GALLERY

PRUNE

Prune roses towards the end of July or the beginning of August. Treat bare stems with a fungicide / insecticide cocktail to kill insect eggs and fungus spores. Feed with a rose food of your choice. Top up the mulch layer, keeping stems free of mulch, and water weekly early in the morning.

Deciduous fruit trees, bushes and vines must be pruned earlier this month during their dormant season.

Semi-hardy and tender shrubs should rather be pruned in September after the danger of frost has passed. This includes plants like Hibiscus, Gardenia, Solanum and Durante.

Don't prune spring-flowering shrubs until they have finished flowering, or you will remove most of the flowering buds.

Trim and cut back woody bits on autumn flowering climbers.





Challenges of working with contractors and how to solve them

For renovation pros, skilled contractors can turn a good project into a great one.

Here is how to work well together:



Whether you are hiring a builder, tiler, carpenter or any other contractor, their skills will be invaluable to the finished outcome of a renovation project. How do you ensure everyone is on the same page and the process is a smooth one?

We share the common challenges we come up against when working with tradespeople and our tried-andtested tips for keeping everything on track.

Challenge 1: Unexpected delays

Hold-ups can be time-consuming and expensive, and often arise when unforeseen changes disrupt a project's timeline. One major cause of this can be a lack of detail when it comes to communicating a plan.

While it might seem that choosing particular furniture or lighting will be the cause of expense, it can often be a miscommunication with a contractor leading to an exhausting and dreaded extra. Over the past 15 years, we have realised the very basics are just as important as the more glamorous elements of a renovation.

The solution: We have developed detailed tender documents and cloud-based sheets. These allow us and our clients to ensure everything we set out to achieve is done with maximum efficiency. Although we may come across something totally unforeseen during a construction project, we have found our level of detail in these early stages to be invaluable.

Challenge 2: Misunderstandings

There are times when even a detailed plan can go awry, leading to jobs not being carried out as you had hoped.

Even with the most extensive technical plans, with every detail covered, the best contractors can sometimes miss important details, requests and requirements, For example, when installing a kitchen, we may ask a contractor to cut the kickboards and ensure the plinth runs through. We may then turn up on site and this has not been actioned.

The solution: We have found this is easily overcome when we run through the plans continue on page 20

in person with the contractors. People communicate in different ways and when we run through a plan, not only are we engaging them, we are working as a team with a much better combined effort towards fantastic results.

When we project manage a job, we aim to turn up on site regularly, at least once a day, at important points to support people. This also opens up opportunities to ask questions.

Be on hand or on site as early as possible if there are any problems. Always be present when any trade contractors are finishing their agreed work to run through snagging items or things you as a designer or your client are not happy with.

Challenge 3: Clashing schedules

If you and your contractor are working to different timelines, it can make things a lot more complicated. Builders and contractors usually work to their own project timelines, and very often this is fitted inbetween other jobs that they all run simultaneously. This can cause knock-on delays if other projects are experiencing unforeseen problems.

The solution: To overcome this, we have a clear brief and timeline. which we run through with the builders and tradespeople before the project starts. We agree a specific date, start time and finish time, and a "time contingency" in case we come across any unforeseen problems or works take longer than anticipated.

This actually happens a lot, particularly when coordinating many different trades. So the more you can anticipate and plan for this, the better.

Challenge 4: Opposing communication styles

Sometimes, frustration can arise when the communication styles of a contractor and a client are different.

Our clients are often from a professional background, in jobs that are often focused around high levels of communication, be it through emails, messaging or phone conversations.

The solution: Balance is key when it comes to communication expectations. Encourage contractors to communicate as quickly as possible while understanding no contractor worth his salt has time to be constantly on their computer or phone. Also try to relay the information to the contractor in such a manner that they are not being bombarded with information and requests.

We hugely enjoy the personable aspects of our job, and love being the go-between, ensuring a smooth project, communicated effectively and successfully,

Challenge 5: Finding the right pro


It is of course vital to consider whether a contractor's work is right for the project you are managing.

Different contractors, tradespeople and specialist trades all have different levels of quality and ways in which they finish their work.

The solution: We recommend you check out a contractor's work beforehand by viewing photos of previous work, having conversations with existing clients and even doing site visits.

Different contractors vary in their capabilities. They all have their place in the market and it is important to select accordingly. You cannot expect to get all three of the following – good quality, quick results and low price. So it is worth being patient and taking the time to find the right person.

Cape Sparrow

Passer melanurus

When checking through the list of birds featured in this column recently it dawned on me that one of our most familiar birds that we may see nearly every day has not been featured. So, this month is devoted to the Cape Sparrow.

This is actually our most handsome, brightly coloured sparrow, with males and females showing different plumage. The male has a distinctive black head and throat with a striking white crescent extending from the eye around the ear. The female has a pale grey head with a diffuse pale crescent. House Sparrow and Southern Grey-headed Sparrow lack the distinctive facial pattern of the Cape Sparrow.


Pairs and small flocks are resident in the estate and can often be seen at bird feeders and in gardens. This is a social bird that often occurs in small groups, particularly where food is provided. The Cape Sparrow mostly eats seeds, foraging in trees and on the ground. The larger seeds of wild grasses and other small plants are preferred. Buds and soft fruits are also taken and insects are eaten, while nestlings seem to be fed exclusively on caterpillars. Birds will also probe in aloes for nectar.





This small bird, which grows to a length of up to 15 centimetres, is quite flexible in its choice of nesting place. Both parent birds collect twigs and any fluff and feathers they can find as nesting material and put it all together in an untidy nest in a tree. Cape Sparrows are said to be monogamous, with breeding pairs staying together all year round and are thought to maintain a partner relationship until one of them dies. Clutches contain between two and six eggs, but typically three or four. Both parents incubate the eggs during the day although at night only the female incubates while the male roosts outside or in the nest. Breeding happens primarily in the summer months, particularly from November to February.

When settled agriculture arrived in the Cape Sparrow's range hundreds of years ago it adapted to cultivated land and with the arrival of settlement it has moved into towns and cities where it has fared well. In Dainfern it is a ubiquitous species and we admire this endearing and cheerful bird which is very much part of our environment.

Puffins!

For quite some time I have been wanting to film those interesting seabirds known as Puffins.

My daughter, Adele, lives in Bath and I found out that not too far from where she stays there is an island on the West Coast of Wales known as Skomer Isle. I asked her to arrange accomodation for me near there. My son and my other daughter, Carol, also decided to come so I had the pleasure of their company for two weeks in the UK.

After a few months of planning the four of us found ourselves approaching Skomer Island in a small boat. We were welcomed by thousands of Puffins!!!! Some in the air, some swimming and others resting on cliff faces. Landing on the island we made our way to the Wick where we knew the Puffins were breeding and where they apparently were very tame so we could see them feeding their chicks. Skomer Island is a bird paradise. There are other interesting birds which I hope to describe in later articles but for now let me concentrate on the Puffins.

They belong to the AUK family. The male is slightly larger than the female.

Their flight is extremely fast like pigeons flapping their wings at 400 times a minute. They spend winter and autumn in the open sea. They can dive very deep (60 meters) and stay under water for about a minute.

They dig burrows in which they lay one egg. Visitors to the Isle are warned to stay on footpaths all the time to protect these burrows. The parent birds catch mainly sand eels which they can keep in their beaks (See photographs) Chicks eat whole fish and grow very rapidly. After six weeks they're fully grown and make their way to the sea at night. They swim away from the shore and do not come back to the island. They are at risk from the large gulls. Watching and filming them was a great thrill and a wonderful memory. Next month I will tell you about some other interesting sea birds.

Distinguished audience- waste management encourages all to breathe new life into old materials.



Her vision for a cleaner, safer, and more vibrant Fourways quickly gained momentum, rallying the community to join forces in making a tangible difference.

Progress and Achievements: A Testament to Community Spirit

When Better Fourways was formed, the vision was simple yet powerful: to restore and maintain our neighbourhood's beauty, safety, and livability. Fourways's rapid changes and decay had not gone unnoticed, and a collective effort was needed to reverse this trend. Easy winter

½ Tbsp. olive oil 2 garlic cloves minced 1 onion diced 1 butternut squash peeled and diced into cubes 4 cups vegetable broth 1-2 tsp. salt

- 1. In a heavy pot, heat olive oil over medium heat. Add onion and garlic. cook until softened, about 5 minutes.
- 2. Add cut up butternut squash and vegetable broth. Bring to a boil then cover and simmer for 15-20 minutes until squash is softened.
- 3. Carefully pour entire contents of pot into blender. Add salt.
- 4. Blend until smooth. Serve in bowls with thyme if desired. Enjoy!

No Knead **Crusty Bread**

3 C all-purpose flour • 1/4 tsp. instant yeast 1 1/4 tsp. salt ● 1 5/8 C water

- 1. Combine dry ingredients in a large bowl and stir in water until well blended.
- 2. Cover bowl with plastic wrap and leave in a warm place to rise for at least 12 hours (16-18 hours is better). To make this easy and to avoid having to use a new piece of plastic wrap each time, I cover the bowl with a plastic shower cap.
- Next, place the dough on a generously floured work surface, sprinkle with flour, and fold it in on top of itself two to three times.
- 4. Turn the bowl you were using at first upside down over the dough and let it rest for 15 minutes.
- 5. After 15 minutes, shape the dough into a ball.
- 6. Coat a smooth cotton towel with flour and put the ball seam side down, dusting the top with more flour.
- 7. Fold sides of towel over top of ball and let rise for 2 hours.
- The dough should double in size.
- 9. 30 minutes before the dough is ready, heat oven to 450° and put a 6 to 8 quart heavy pot with a cover (pyrex, cast iron, enamel or ceramic work best) in to heat.
- 10. Remove the pot from the oven and dump the dough ball seam side up into the pan.
- 11. Cover the pot and bake for 30 minutes.
- 12. Then remove the lid and bake another 15 to 30 minutes or until the loaf is nicely browned.
- 13. Remove from oven and cool on rack.
