

Dear Residents

Nature Association Update

Spring is in the air. It has been a busy month having completed the grass cutting, moribund removal, and we are up to date with most invasives.

Ongoing Maintenance

Our teams are now in Bush Baby Bird Walk tackling the Cestrum in one section of the forest area which is quite bad and also Moth Catchers are still needing some attention. We shall get round to this shortly.

An appeal to all!

We have noticed how many golfers and walkers use this area as a toilet, where tissues are just left in the grass and cans and bottles are just thrown into this lovely area. We appeal to all, to respect our nature areas and use the bins that are provided throughout the Estate.

Sawgrass Dams

Sawgrass Dams have been a constant worry this year, with all of the sewer leaks which encourage the reeds to grow fast and the undermining at the weirs are also problematic. More and more water comes into our dams from upstream in the rainy season, so the aim was to get to the desilting of Dam 1 in Sawgrass this year, but with all the other upgrades and rehabilitating of broken gabion areas, this has been delayed.

This observance highlights the ecological benefits of trees, such as improving air quality, providing habitat for wildlife, and combating climate change.


In South Africa, Arbor Day was officially established in 1983.

LEGAL MATTERS

How does the eviction process work?

In order to evict an unlawful occupier from the residential property, the procedure in terms of Section 4 and 5 of the Prevention of Illegal eviction from and Unlawful occupation of Land Act 19 of 1998 must be complied with.

The main purpose of the Act is to protect both occupiers and landowners by providing for the prohibition of illegal eviction on the one hand and procedures for eviction of unlawful occupiers on the other.

Procedure:

Step 1: Letter of demand and cancellation

It must be established whether the lease agreement has come to an end. The tenant must be an unlawful occupier, meaning that the lease agreement has come to an end, yet the tenant remains in unlawful occupation of the property without the consent of the landlord.

In terms of Section 14 of the Consumer protection Act, Rental Housing Act and Prevention of Illegal eviction Act, one must specify what the breach is and/or the reasons for termination. Then one must allow them 20 working days to remedy the breach. If they fail, then another letter must be sent stating that there is a cancellation. Thereafter, the eviction application is launched.

Step 2: Draft the eviction papers

If the lessee fails to remedy breach and the lease has been cancelled, and the tenant remains in occupation of the premises then one should consult attorneys who will proceed with the legal process without further delay.

Step 3: Issue summons and/or application

The attorney will attend court and request the clerk to issue the summons and notice of motion.

Step 4: Ex Parte application

This is the first part of the application. The

purpose of this application is that the attorney obtains the consent from the court to proceed with the application for eviction and application for the issuing of the Section 4 Notices.

Step 5: Issuing of the notice by the clerk of the court

Once the court has granted the above, same will be given to the clerk of the court for immediate issuing.

Step 6: Service of papers

The Sheriff will be instructed to serve the necessary papers.

Step 7: We attend to the index and paginating of the court file The above is done when all original papers and returns of services was received from the Sheriff.

Step 8: Return date (second court hearing)

The court may grant further orders with regards to the finalisation of the eviction. Before the court will grant the eviction, it must consider all the relevant circumstances and be in a position to rule on the application. Special circumstances may be presented by the occupier.

Step 9: Court order

The court order will clearly indicate on which date the occupier must vacate the premises. If they fail, the Sheriff will remove them. If the order has been granted, it must be served by the Sheriff on the unlawful occupier.

Step 10: Service of court order

The Sheriff will serve the court order if the unlawful occupier is not present at the hearing.

Step 11: Removal by the Sheriff

If the unlawful occupier fails to vacate the property on the date stipulated in the court order, a Warrant of ejectment will be issued. The Sheriff will then attend to the removal of the unlawful occupier/s.

The Fish Pond

One of the first things I did when I came to live in Dainfern was to build a fish pond.



My son had told me that a friend of his had a tiny pond not bigger than about one meter square. There were some small Koi in there and a Giant Kingfisher had been trying to catch them. I thought that if a Kingfisher could try his luck in such a small pond then surely it would go for a bigger pond. So with the help of my gardener and my son we dug a large hole, lined it with canvas sheeting, placed nice rocks around the edges and filled it with water.

I did not like Koi and got some indigenous Tilapia to attract Kingfishers. Meanwhile I enjoyed seeing

the waterlilies grow. I noticed that the moment I filled the pond up with water, a spider made its web across the sides. It was known as the Long Jawed Water Spider. It's wonderful how in Nature as soon as a place for this spider to survive became available it was there to take it !!

The pond filled up with wild life very quickly. The water lilies spread out across the pond and one morning as I looked out of a window I saw the leaves of the lilies moving. Something was disturbing them. It proved to be a Reed Cormorant after my Tilapias! I wanted to film this but as soon as the cormorant saw me it flew away. I put my camera on a tripod and in position.I waited until the Cormorant came back and while it was under water I quickly closed the curtains with the camera just peeping through and got shots of the bird coming out of the water with a large fish and eating it. It came back for about three days then disappeared.



I had several interesting visitors to this fish pond and in subsequent articles I will tell you more about them.

The Little Grebe - also known as the Dabchick - is occasionally observed in Dainfern, usually in one of the ponds and dams on the estate with vegetation, which is where it can hide from its prey.

It is seldom seen on the river as it generally avoids fast flowing water. As a diving species and a skilful swimmer, it is able to pursue its fish and invertebrate prey underwater. The adult is easily identified in summer as it is mostly dark above and has a rich rufous neck, cheeks and flanks and bright yellow gape.

The bird also has a distinctive farcarrying call, sounding like a rapid weet-weet-weet, which has been likened to a horse whinnying. In non-breeding plumage the rufous is replaced by a brownish-buff colour, but even then, the small size of this bird makes identification relatively easy. It has the habit of sitting in the water with its rump positioned higher than its back.

Keep an eye open for this enigmatic species on the estate. As long as our dams are in good shape they will be around!

Understanding our feline companions

As much as we love our feline companions, they can certainly challenge our inter-species relationship. They have ways of communicating to other cats which we don't necessarily understand (or like) but it is important to understand what they are trying to say in context.

They don't mean to offend us but cats "talk" in the following ways when they want to get their message across. These four main types of marking, which can drive us crazy and ruin a few relationships, are completely normal...to them. Before we rehome a cat for some of the below mentioned behaviours, let's see their motivation for performing them.

Urine spraying

In communal areas, spraying conveys information to other cats about an individual's age, gender, sexual availability and maturity, their degree of stress, medical condition and even what he has recently eaten. The resident cat's spray helps an intruder cat "read" the environment and in turn, when the transient cat sprays over his mark, will convey information about himself back to the resident cat. This olfactory and visual marker is aimed at conflict avoidance by claiming or allocating time sharing of the area.

An indoor cat feeling threatened by perceived threats or upset by changes at home will be nervous, anxious, or aggravated. A socialised cat may begin to spray his own bed if he finds the novelty too distressing. By spraying on windows, curtains, laundry baskets, electric sockets, entry/exit points, and furnishings he is marking his territory and showing his angst.



As for those of us who know, the smell can make our eyes water and it's not the easiest to get rid of. Unfortunately, it is one of the leading causes for the rehoming of a cat.

Bunting:

Ever wondered why a cat likes to rub himself against you? This tactile and olfactory marking strategy starts with the cat grooming himself. His outer ears discharge a wax-like substance and along with his facial and caudal glands, secretes an oily substance which goes onto his body. Pheromones are released, and he can deposit them by rubbing against people, cats, other animals, and objects using his head, sides, and tail. This activity produces oxytocin, promoting bonding and relaxation. It is used in communal settings to exchange scents.

Scratching

Outdoor cats hunt and climb and need to sharpen/maintain their claws. We may think they are purely trying to test us when they scratch the new leather couch, but they are busy leaving both visual and scent markers. Like an individual signature. The actual scratch will carry pheromones allowing other cats to know that the area is occupied and when they were last there. Neighbourhood cats rarely examine or scratch on top of others scratch marks to avoid confrontation. Scratching can either relieve anxiety or shows enjoyment and denotes confidence.



Middening

This is a strong visual and olfactory marker left by a scared, and anxious cat to show his unease by leaving exposed faeces in a shared open area. It is often found where many outdoor cats reside, where competition to secure resources is rife. It is a declaration of a cat's existence and identity, a most valuable signal to other cats. If middening is found indoors in frequently used high traffic areas like the bottom of staircases, kitchen entrances and front doors, the cat is trying to ensure others find it.

When we understand what they are trying to tell us, we can gauge how they are feeling. As frustrating as it can be for humans, it's "cat speak" to them.

Star Events

in September

The change of season also comes with a change of stars.



This month Venus is beautifully bright in the West after sunset, and Mercury is also up at the same time and direction but it is only visible with a telescope.

Saturn starts to be visible in the East around 7pm and it is in an orientation that this unusual – it is edge on with the rings. Because of this, Saturn isn't as distinct as usual, but it is wonderful to see something new. There are always interesting things going on in space!

On 19 August we were blessed with a Supermoon – this is when the moon is closer to earth than usual during a full moon and appears larger to those who look at the moon often. I didn't get much sleep that night (some people can't sleep during a full moon), but it was lovely to be able to walk outside without a torch due to the bright moon light.

The next Supermoon is on 18 September, which also happens to be a partial lunar eclipse. Unfortunately, the lunar eclipse is a tiny one at 0.08 Magnitude so you probably won't even notice it unless you look at 4:44am. I, for one, plan to be asleep at that time. But you might hear a lot about it on social media which tends to exaggerate things...

At the end of September, we will enter the Draconids meteor shower, which will peak on 8-9 October. You might notice more shooting stars than usual if you spend the night looking up.

Change appears to be a part of life, from the smallest scales to the largest scales. Embrace the change, however challenging it may be.

Does my kiddo have dyslexia? And what can I do?
